

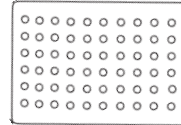


Preportioned Cookie Dough Handling

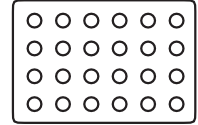
.5 oz., 1 oz. and 1.25 oz. Cookies

Step 1: Place 0.5 oz. frozen cookies on a lined baking pan in a 6 x 10 configuration.
PREP Place 1 oz. and 1.25 oz. frozen cookies on a lined baking pan in a 4 x 6 configuration.
Store unbaked dough in freezer.

6 x 10 configuration



4 x 6 configuration



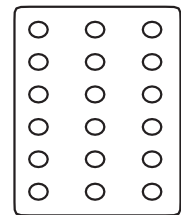
Step 2: **Rack Oven:** Bake 0.5 oz. cookies at 350°F for Approximately 6-9 minutes. Bake 1 oz. cookies at 350°F for approximately 8-10 minutes. Bake 1.25 oz. cookies at 350° for approximately 10-12 minutes.
BAKING **Convection Oven:** Bake 0.5 oz. at 325°F with LOW FAN for approximately 5-7 minutes. Bake 1 oz. cookies at 325°F with LOW FAN for approximately 7-9 minutes. Bake 1.25 oz. at 325°F with LOW FAN for approximately 10-12 minutes.
Turn tray halfway through baking time.

2 oz. Cookies

Step 1: Place 2 oz. cookies in a 3 x 6 configuration.
PREP Store unbaked dough in freezer.

Step 2: **Rack Oven:** Bake 2 oz. cookies at 350-375°F for approximately 14-17 minutes.

BAKING **Convection Oven:** Bake 2 oz. cookie at 325°F with LOW FAN for approximately 13-16 minutes.
Turn tray halfway through baking time.



3 x 6 configuration

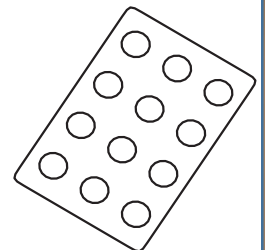
3.25 oz. Cookies

Step 1: Place 3.25 oz. frozen cookies on a lined baking pan in a 3 x 4 configuration.
PREP Store unbaked dough in freezer.

3 x 4 configuration

Step 2: **Rack Oven:** Bake 3.25 oz. cookies at 350-375°F for approximately 14-19 minutes.

BAKING **Convection Oven:** Bake 3.25 oz. cookies at 325°F with LOW FAN for approximately 13-18 minutes.
Turn tray halfway through baking time.



Cookies should appear slightly underbaked when removed from the oven. Cookies will continue to bake for about 2 minutes after removal from oven.
